Some do this by serving as Council members, on various Committees, mission awareness and fundraising in parishes, helping with our training course, ongoing financial support etc; as well as attendance at various gatherings where the VC spirit of welcome, faith, friendship and mutual support is kept alive and enhanced.

How to become a member of VC: There are several ways of becoming a member of VC as follows:-

- 1. By becoming a volunteer on active service with one of our partner organisations overseas.
- 2. By serving as a Home Based Volunteer on a Committee or in a variety of situations for at least 6 months
- 3. By being invited to be an Honorary Member in recognition of exceptional services rendered to VC.
- 4. New Members apply for full or associate membership and are formally ratified by the VC Council.

Simply put the full membership sees the VC member acting from a faith motivation whereas associate membership requires only that the VC member respects the Catholic ethos and values of the Association.

All those who are offered assignments are asked to become either full or associate members of the VC Association. Both full and associate members are invited to attend and vote at the annual general meeting, can be elected to the Council and take an equal and active part in the association. Membership is free to those who travel overseas and for the first year after their return. Thereafter there is a small annual fee payable, (currently €25).
